U18 National Finals & Grand Final Sprint	The U18 National Final will be held in Melbourne at the MCG before the start of the 2018 Toyota AFL Grand Final on 29th September 2018. The 10 <b>Finalists</b> will compete over 100m in one race only. The first 2 runners from the U18 National Final race ( <b>Grand Finalists</b> ) will progress to compete in the 2018 Gatorade Grand Final Half Time Sprint (" <b>Grand Final</b> ") to be held at the Melbourne Cricket Ground on 29 <sup>th</sup> September, 2018.
Entry Limits	One entry per person. Entrants may only enter in their usual State of residence.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## "FINDING THE FASTEST U18 AMATEUR AFL PLAYER" (the "Competition")

The following terms and conditions (**Terms and Conditions**) apply for "Finding the Fastest U18 Amateur AFL Player" competition (the **Promotion**). By submitting an entry into the Promotion, the entrant warrants that they have read, understood and accepted these Terms and Conditions.

1. The Promotion is conducted by PepsiCo Australia Holdings Pty Ltd (ABN 25 079 719 743) of 799 Pacific Highway, Chatswood NSW 2067 (the **Promoter**).

2. Information on how to enter the Promotion forms part of the Terms and Conditions.

3. Entry is only open to Eligible Entrants.

Employees of the Promoter (and their immediate families), participating retailers and agencies associated with this Promotion are ineligible to enter.

4. Entries are deemed to be received at the time of receipt by the Promoter and not at the time of transmission by the entrant.

5. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and AFL registration status) and disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, who tampers with the entry process or who submits an entry that the Promoter, in its sole discretion, deems to be offensive, inappropriate, defamatory or otherwise not in keeping with the spirit of the Promotion. The Promoter may refuse participation for any entrant where it believes the entrant has suffered, or is suffering, from any disease, injury or illness or is otherwise unfit to participate.

6. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. Incomplete, indecipherable, or illegible entries will be deemed invalid.

7. This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in the determination of winners. Each Eligible Entrant will be individually judged based purely on the time in which they can complete a 100m sprint, as determined by the Promoter in its absolute discretion. The Promoter's decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

8. Within 5 Business Days of the end of the Registration Period, each Eligible Entrant will be notified by email further details about the Heats.

9. Within 5 Business Days of the conclusion of the State Heat events, each Eligible Entrant will be notified by email further details about the AFL Pre-Game State Final events.

10. Within 5 Business Days of the conclusion of the State Heats events, each Eligible Entrant will be notified by email further details about the U18 National Final event.

11. The State Final winners (10 in total - 2 per state) that participate in the U18 National Final at the 2018 Toyota AFL Grand Final (29<sup>th</sup> September 2018) will receive the following prize, depending on their place of residence:

- if they reside in a State other than Victoria, 2 x economy class return airfares (with an airline of the Promoter's choice) from their State of residence to Melbourne, departing Friday 28th September and returning Saturday 29th September 2018;
- 1 x night's accommodation for 2 people (1 room twin share or similar) at a hotel of the promoter's choice on Friday 28th September 2018;
- 2 x tickets to the 2018 Toyota AFL Grand Final on September 29th 2018;
- hotel transfers to and from the venue (MCG).

If a State Final is under the age of 18, they must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian when attending the finals, including the travel and accommodation described above. Flights and accommodation are subject to booking and availability.

12. No prize is transferable or exchangeable, nor can it be redeemed for cash. In the event for any reason a winner does not take an element of any prize at the time stipulated by the Promoter then that element of the prize will be forfeited by the winner and cash will not be supplied for that element of the prize. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the value of a prize.

13. Where a prize is unavailable for any reason, the Promoter may substitute for that prize another item of equal or higher value as determined by the Promoter. Without limiting the foregoing, the Promoter may, in its absolute discretion, substitute cash for any prize (the amount of cash being equal to the prize value specified for that prize in the Schedule).

14. The total cost of providing the benefits referred to in clause 11 in these Terms and Conditions is up to \$28,000 (ex GST), depending on the winners' places of residence. For the avoidance of doubt, the Promoter will not be responsible for, or provide to any person, insurance, spending money or any other incidental or personal costs in relation to the Promotion or participation in the Promotion (**Personal Costs**), and each Eligible Entrant, Heat Winners, State Final Winners and Grand Finalists will be solely responsible for any Personal Costs.

16. The Heat Winners, State Final Winners and Grand Finalists (**Winners**) must, at the Promoter's request, participate in any marketing and promotional activity in relation to the Promotion, free of charge. Entrants consent to the Promoter using the entrant's name, likeness, image and/or voice in the event they are a Winner (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this Promotion (including any outcome), and promoting the Promoter and the Promoter's products.

19. If this Promotion is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law to disqualify any entrant or modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the Promotion, as appropriate.

20. Other than any liability that cannot be excluded by law (including the Australian Consumer Law), the Promoter (including its officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with this Promotion or any prizes; and any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity), whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the Promotion, including, but not limited to, where arising out of the following:

- any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control);
- any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference;
- any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter;
