- Accurate VFL Match Day stats are recorded in consultation with the VFL Coaches
- Import match day codes into VFL match and upload to the network
- Delivery of post-match footage and statistics to VFL coaches
- Integrate VFL coaches' codes into match day package
- Provide VFL analysis on VFL Match trends and additional coding as required by VFL coaching staff
- Management of VFL match day technology
- Maintenance of VFL match day and development player databases
- Assist VFL Coaches with the development of meeting templates
