Notes:	The AFL Anti-Doping Tribunal ( <b>Tribunal</b> ) found that Mr Murray violated clause 10.2 of the Australian Football Anti-Doping Code ( <b>Code</b> ) by the Presence of a Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites in a Sample that he provided following his participation in the match between Collingwood Football Club and Richmond Football Club on 28 July 2018. The Sample tested positive for the Presence of benzoylecgonine, a metabolite of cocaine which is a Prohibited Substance under the WADA Prohibited List.  The period of Ineligibility imposed on Mr Murray commenced on 17 August 2018 being the date a Provisional Suspension was imposed on him. As such, Mr Murray is eligible to participate in sport from 17 February 2020. By operation of the Code, Mr Murray may return to training on 17 December 2019.
