

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

FFC Christmas in July Promotion

1. The FFC Christmas in July promotional period (**CIJ Promotional Period**) for the FFC Christmas in July promotion commences at 12.01am WST Wednesday 8th July 2015 and ends at 4.00pm WST Thursday 16nd July 2015.
2. Instructions on how to enter, prize details and other information contained within the promotional advertisements form part of these terms and conditions. By participating in this promotion entrants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
3. Only participants that sign up with Velocity and choose Fremantle Dockers or register Fremantle Dockers as an existing Velocity member are eligible to win the prize.
4. Only participants who enter correct and valid details regarding Full Name, Mobile Number, Email Address, Velocity Frequent Flyer Number and Fremantle Dockers Membership Number (or seat number)(**Nominated Seats**) for the Round 16 AFL fixture, Fremantle Dockers v Carlton on Saturday the 18th of July are eligible to win the prize.
