

THE CLYDESDALE CLASSIC – CARLTON DRAUGHT DERBY PROMOTION

'WIN A YEAR OF BEER'

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and the prizes form part of these conditions of entry. Participation in this competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. This competition is a promotion run by Fremantle Football Club Ltd (Fremantle Dockers), 31 Veterans Parade, Cockburn Central WA 6164 (The "Promoter"). The co-promoter is Carlton and United Breweries (trading as CUB Pty Ltd) of 77 Southbank Boulevard, Southbank, Victoria, 3006. (ABN 76 004 056 106) (Co-Promoter)
3. The Promotion commences on Monday 10 July at 9:00am AWST and closes on Sunday 16 July, 2017 at 5:40pm AWST (Promotion Period).
4. Entry is open to all residents of Australia over the age of 18 years. Excluded, are employees of the Promoter and Co-Promoter, firms or companies associated with this Promotion, and their immediate families. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step/grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
