## CBD SHUTTLE

Route	Now operating to and from Matagarup Bridge Bus Stands
661	The Route 661, CBD shuttle will now run as a circular route between Perth and <b>Matagarup Bridge Bus Stands, on the East Perth side of the bridge</b> via Wellington St, Milligan St, and Adelaide/St Georges Tce. Buses will run every 3 - 5 minutes between 11.52am and 2.35pm. Fans will now need to walk over the Matagarup Bridge to get to Optus Stadium. Route 661 will no longer enter Elizabeth Quay Bus Station so passengers can instead board from St Georges Tce.

## BUSES

Route	Departing
650	From <b>Karrinyup Bus Station</b> via Innaloo (Stand 5). Departing every 5 minutes, commencing at 12.00pm with the last bus at 1.55pm. <b>After the match</b> buses now depart Stadium Bus Station from <b>Stands 18 - 22</b> .
652	From <b>Mirrabooka Bus Station</b> (Stand 12) via Alexander Dr. Departing every 5 – 10 minutes, commencing at 12.03pm with the last bus at 1.58pm. <b>After the match</b> buses depart Stadium Bus Station from Stands 14 & 15.
653	From <b>Morley Bus Station</b> (Stand 6) via Beaufort St. Departing every 5 – 10 minutes, commencing at 12.05pm with the last bus at 2.00pm. <b>After the match</b> buses depart Stadium Bus Station from Stands 16 & 17.
654	From <b>Ellenbrook Town Centre</b> (Stop 22417) via Bassendean Station. Departing every 5 – 10 minutes, commencing at 11.48am with the last bus at 1.43pm. <b>After the match</b> buses now depart Stadium Bus Station from <b>Stands 12 &amp; 13, on the west side of Perth Stadium Bus Station</b> .
656	From <b>Canning Vale</b> (Stop 10520) via Bentley Plaza. Departing every 5 – 10 minutes, commencing at 11.55am with the last bus at 1.50pm. <b>After the match</b> buses now depart Stadium Bus Station from <b>Stands 10 &amp; 11</b> .
657	From <b>Curtin University Bus Station</b> (Stand 6). Departing every 5 – 10 minutes, commencing at 12.10pm with the last bus at 2.05pm. <b>After the match</b> buses now depart Stadium Bus Station from <b>Stands 8 &amp; 9</b> .
658	From <b>Hamilton Hill</b> (Stop 25562) via Kardinya Park. Departing every 5 - 10 minutes, commencing at 11.45am with the last bus at 1.40pm. <b>After the match</b> buses depart Stadium Bus Station from Stands 4 & 5.
659	From <b>Fremantle Station</b> (Stand 2) via Canning Hwy. Departing every 5 minutes, commencing at 11.54am with the last bus at 1.49pm. <b>After the match</b> buses depart Stadium Bus Station from Stands 1, 2 & 3.

## TRAINS

**Trains on the Armadale Line stop at Stadium Station every weekend, from first service to last service.**

**To get you to the match, direct Perth Stadium shuttles depart Perth Station approximately every 15 minutes from 11.34am, with the last train before bounce-down arriving at 2.31pm.**

Train Line	
<b>Armadale</b>	Passengers are reminded Armadale Line trains are now stopping at Stadium Station from first to last service. Take an Armadale Line train straight to Perth Stadium Station. To get you to the match, trains will depart Armadale approximately every 15 minutes, commencing at 5.15am. <b>After the match</b> the last train departs Stadium Station (Eastern Concourse) at 2.20am (midnight).
<b>Thornlie</b>	Trains stopping at Stadium Station will depart Thornlie from 9.05am with increased frequency from 11.05am. There will be no trains to Thornlie from Perth between 3.37pm and 7.18pm. <b>After the match</b> take the Armadale Line to connect with train replacement buses (Route 908), operating between Thornlie and Cannington Stations.
<b>Midland</b>	Take a Midland Line train to Perth and change to an Armadale Line service to Perth Stadium Station. <b>After the match</b> take a train to Perth from the Eastern Concourse. and transfer to the Midland Line. The last connecting train departs Stadium Station at 1.19am.
<b>Fremantle</b>	Football specials depart Fremantle approximately every 15 minutes between 12.35pm and 1.35pm. <b>After the match</b> trains depart <b>Platform 3 via the Western Concourse</b> and travel express to City West then all stops to Fremantle between 5.16pm and 6.16pm. After 6.16pm take a train to Perth from the Eastern Concourse and transfer to the Fremantle Line. The last connecting train departs Stadium Station at 1.19am.
<b>Mandurah</b>	Take a Mandurah Line train to Perth and change to an Armadale Line service to Perth Stadium Station. <b>After the match</b> take a train to Perth from the Eastern Concourse and transfer to the Mandurah Line. The last connecting train departs Stadium Station at 1.19am.
<b>Joondalup</b>	Football specials depart Butler approximately every 15 minutes between 11.50am and 1.35pm. <b>After the match</b> trains depart <b>Platform 4 via the Western Concourse</b> and travel express to Leederville then all stops to Butler between 5.21pm and 6.26pm, with some services terminating at Clarkson. After 6.26pm take a train to Perth from the Eastern Concourse and transfer to the Joondalup Line. The last connecting train departs Stadium Station at 1.19am.
<b>Claisebrook and Mclver Stations</b>	Take a Perth train shuttle from the Eastern Concourse and get off at Perth Station, then transfer to bus Route 905 from Wellington St after Forrest Pl (Stop 12924). Route 905 runs on a 10 minute frequency between Perth Busport and East Perth, stopping at Claisebrook, Mclver and Perth stations between 4.47pm and 6.52pm.

**If you're leaving early you will need to take a Perth train shuttle from the Eastern Concourse and transfer to a timetabled service.**
