This event was held at 10:30am on Friday 22nd of February in the upstairs Function Room.

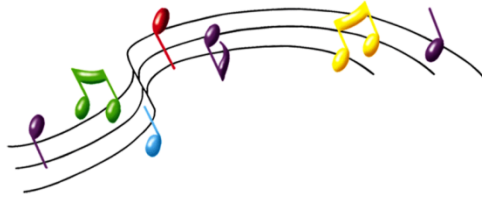
We were hoping to have a guest speaker from HFC however owing to circumstances beyond our control this didn't occur.
