NORTH MELBOURNE FOOTBALL CLUB LIMITED "BOX ON - KICK FOR A CAR" PROMOTION

FAQ's

Q. How far away will the bins be from where I will kick from?

A. The bins are 240 litre wheelie bins and they will be 25 metres away. Each competitor will have up to 30 seconds to complete each kick they are eligible to have.

Q. What exactly do I need to do to have a successful kick?

A. For a kick to be considered successful, the football must land in one of the wheelie bins on the full and remain in one of the wheelie bins.

Q. Who are the players that I can select from to represent me?

A. The players are Lindsay Thomas, Robbie Tarrant, Drew Petrie, Aaron Black, Ryan Bastinac and Daniel Wells. Each competitor can only have one player represent them.

Q. How many competitors can each player represent?

A. Each player can represent a maximum of 5 different competitors.

Q. What happens if a competitor successfully kicks a ball into one of the bins before I have my kick in the competition?

A. All competitors will get to have their kicks even if a previous competitor successfully kicks a ball into one of the bins.

Q. What happens if multiple competitors successfully kick a ball into one of the bins?

There will be a tie-breaker round between those competitors who successfully kicked a ball into one of the bins. The tie-breaker will require those who qualify or their nominated North Melbourne Player to kick a AFL Sherrin Leather Match Day Football from the middle edge of the centre square and aim for the football to stop as close as possible to the centre of the ground which will be marked with a white square (25 metres from the point where the football was kicked from)

After each kick the distance from the centre of the ground to where the football stopped will be measured and recorded against the competitor. The measurement will be from the centre of the ground to the closest part of the football. In the case where the football stops further than 1.55 metres from the centre of the ground, the kick will be considered unsuccessful and won't be measured.

In the event two or more competitors have their football touching the marked centre of the ground or partially overlapping the marked centre in the tie breaker round, a second tie breaker round will be required to separate these competitors. The second tie-breaker round will be exactly as above.

The donor with the closest recorded distance from the centre of the ground will be declared the winner of a Mazda3 SP20 Skyactiv valued at up to \$31,510 including on-road costs, registration and compulsory insurance. Any costs in excess of the value of the car (including any vehicle model upgrades or optional extras requested by the winner, if permitted by the promoter in its absolute discretion), are the sole responsibility of the winner.

Q. What happens if no competitor successfully kicks a ball into one of the bins?

A. All competitors will take part in the tie-breaker round.

Q. Can I purchase additional kicks on the day of the event?

Yes. All competitors who have made their donation prior to 12pm on the day of the competition can purchase additional kicks. Competitors can do this up until 5 minutes after the end of the first round of competition.

Q. Where do I need to go on the day of the competition?

A. On the day of the event, competitors must report to the Box On – Kick for a Car registration desk at North Melbourne Football Ground, 204-206 Arden Street, North Melbourne, 3051 by 11:45am on 18/08/13 where they will be advised of their kicking order position. Failure to report to the registration desk by this time may result in disqualification from the promotion.

Q. How old do I need to be to enter the competition?

A. The opportunity to participate in this promotion is available to all people aged 18 years or older who make a donation to the North Melbourne Football Club by 12:00pm on 18/08/13. Donors **are** able to have people aged under 18 represent them in the competition.

Q. Can I have someone represent me in the competition if I can't make it on the day of the competition?

A. Yes. In the event one of the donors is unable to represent themselves, they are able to nominate another person (other than a senior listed North Melbourne Football Club player) to represent them in the Box On – Kick for a Car promotion.

Q. What happens if the player who was going to represent me gets injured and is unable to represent me?

A. In the event your selected player is unable to represent you, a senior listed North Melbourne Player who played in North Melbourne's round 21 game against Essendon will be substituted in to represent you.

Q. Do I need to be a member of the North Melbourne Football Club to participate?

A. No. Anyone over the age of 18 is able to pay the required donation to be able to participate.
