THE ROLE

The role of the assistant coach is to assist the senior coach in all coaching requirements for Richmond's VFLW program. The assistant coach will also be required to coach and develop the players under the direction of the VFLW senior coach. The assistant coaches will also be required to prepare and implement weekly training plans for the squad and managing a line (back line/midfield/forward line) both at training and on match day – ensuring the highest possible coaching standards across the Club's female football program.

TASK PROFILE

Key responsibilities also include the design and implementation of the program's coaching curriculum. Assistant coaches will be a key driver of Individual Player Development plans, both in planning and delivery. To achieve their potential, players are to be coached in such a way that develops the skills, physical attributes and football knowledge, and the personal characteristics and self-esteem of each player.
