- Provide clinical and medical guidance to the AFLW Rehab Coordinator around training progressions and restrictions to ensure safe management and appropriate management for all injury types entering rehabilitation
- Liaise with AFLW Head Physio, AFLW team managers, and other AFLW staff to ensure appropriate staffing & equipment is available for all rehabilitation session
- Manages and conducts treatment services for all players within training and game hours during the AFLW Season
- Travels interstate with the team as required
- Attends VFLW trainings weekly during the AFLW off-season period to facilitate appropriate management of AFLW Players and development of VFLW Staff

The ideal candidate must possess a physiotherapy degree and have experience working as a physiotherapist within a sporting team. A masters or graduate certificate qualification in is preferred but not essential.
