



# MATCH DAY RAFFLE TERMS & CONDITIONS

## ROUND 2 v FREMANTLE & ROUND 4 v CARLTON

1. By entering into this lottery, you (**Entrant**) accept these terms and conditions.
2. The entity facilitating the draw is GCFC Ltd ABN 47 144 555 822 (**GCFC**) and the name of the lottery is the 'Gold Coast SUNS Foundation Match Day Raffle'.
3. The lottery is a category 2 game conducted under the *Charitable and Non-Profit Gaming Act 1999 (Qld)*.
4. This lottery is conducted in association with Gold Coast SUNS home games during the 2019 Toyota AFL Premiership Season (**Season**). These terms and conditions relate to the lottery conducted during Round 2 and Round 4 of the Season, held at Metricon Stadium Queensland (**Venue**) on Sunday, 31 March 2019 and Sunday, 14 April 2019 (**Match**).
5. Entry is open to all residents of Australia who attend a Match at the Venue, excluding employees and officers of GCFC, any agency associated with the promotion of the lottery or conducting of the draw, and their immediate families. Entrants must be 18 years or over to purchase tickets.
6. Entry into the lottery costs \$10 per entry with a total of 1,000 tickets available for purchase upon provision of the Entrant's email address and phone number.
7. A person may enter the lottery on more than one occasion in accordance with the procedure specified in these terms and conditions, although GCFC reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to refuse to accept any single entry.
8. To enter and be eligible to win, entrants must purchase a ticket from a roaming salesperson or visit a ticket booth within the Venue at one of the Matches.
9. The lottery opens for entry on Sunday, 31 March 2019 at 1:45PM local time and closes on Sunday, 14 April 2019 at the end of half time of the Match (approximately 4:00PM local time). Entry tickets will be emailed to the person via the email details provided.
10. This lottery is a game of chance and skill plays no part in determining the winner.
11. The prize for this lottery is a Corporate Hospitality Suite for eighteen (18) guests at the Venue for use at Round 8 of the Season, for the Gold Coast Suns v Melbourne match on Saturday, 11 May 2019. This prize also includes catering from O'Brien's Group Catering to the value of \$1,200. The total value of the prize is \$5,000 (including GST).
12. The winning ticket number will be announced at the Match on Sunday, 14 April 2019, during the ¾ time break. The winner's details will be announced over the loudspeaker and displayed at the Match on the Venue's big screen. The winner will be contacted via the phone number or email address provided at entry.
13. Prizes are not transferable and are not redeemable for cash.
14. GCFC may verify the validity of entries and disqualify any Entrant without notice for providing false information, failing to comply with these terms and conditions or tampering with the entry process. GCFC is not responsible for any technical difficulties which prevent an otherwise valid entry from being received by GCFC.
15. Subject to paragraph 18, GCFC will not be liable for any loss or damage (however caused), suffered by the Entrant in connection with these terms and conditions or the lottery.
16. Except as contemplated by paragraph 18, nothing in these terms and conditions is intended to limit any rights of the Entrant under the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth) or the Charitable and Non-Profit Gaming Act 1999 (Qld).

17. If the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth) or any other legislation provides that there is a guarantee in relation to any good or service supplied by GCFC in connection with these terms and conditions or the lottery and GCFC's liability for failing to comply with that guarantee cannot be excluded but may be limited, then paragraph 19 does not apply to that liability and instead GCFC's liability for such failure is limited to (at GCFC's election):
  - a. in the case of the supply of goods, GCFC replacing the goods or supplying equivalent goods, repairing the goods, paying the cost of replacing the goods or of acquiring equivalent goods, or paying the cost of having the goods repaired; or
  - b. in the case of supply of services, GCFC supplying the services again or paying the cost of having the services supplied again.
18. The Entrant is liable for and indemnifies GCFC from and against any loss or damage (including legal costs) however caused, suffered or incurred by GCFC in connection with these terms and conditions, the lottery or any act or omission of the Entrant.
19. All liability for government charges, expenses, taxes or any other tax or duty is the sole responsibility of each winner.

By entering into the lottery, the Entrant consents to GCFC using, modifying and disclosing the Entrant's name, likeness, image or voice (including photograph, film or recording) in any media, for an unlimited time without further reference, payment or any other compensation to the Entrant for the promotion of any products or services of GCFC, including sending the Entrant electronic messages.

By providing your personal information, you agree to such use by the GCFC.

26. The laws of Queensland, Australia apply to the lottery and these terms and conditions. Entrants irrevocably submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Queensland courts in connection with the lottery.
27. Paragraphs 17, 18, 19 and 20 survive termination or expiry of the lottery.
