



Midsumma Carnival Competition Terms & Conditions

- Competition:** Midsumma Carnival AFLW Pride Guernsey Competition (**Competition**).
- Promoter:** The Competition will be conducted by Footscray Football Club Limited (ABN 68 005 226 595) trading as “Western Bulldogs” of 417 Barkly Street, Footscray, Victoria, 3011.
- Competition Period:** The Competition commences at 11.00am (AEST) on 20 January 2019 and will close at 5.00pm (AEST) on 20 January 2019. Entries submitted after the closing date will not be accepted or valid.
- Entry Restrictions:** Eligibility to enter the Competition is subject to these Entry Restrictions. Entry is open to residents aged 18 years or over of Victoria. Entry is not open to residents of other States or Territories of Australia and to person deemed ‘ineligible’ as set out below.
- Competition Entry Procedure:** To enter, eligible entrants must, during the Competition Period, register their details via the iPads at the Western Bulldogs stand at the Midsumma Carnival. Only one entry per person is permitted. If additional entries are submitted, only the first entry received by the Promoter will be included in the Competition. Any entrant found to be submitting multiple entries may be disqualified from the Competition, with their entry deemed ineligible. To validly enter the Competition, entrants must provide their full name, post code, contact telephone number and email address. Any incomplete entries will be deemed invalid. Entry into the Competition signifies your agreement with these terms and conditions.
- Entry Requirements:** The winner must be aged 18 years or older in order to claim the prize. Entrants must produce documentation to establish (to the Promoter’s satisfaction) the validity of entry before being awarded a prize. This documentation will include photographic proof of identity, age and place of residence.
- Competition Draw Details:** The drawing of the winner of the Competition (runner-up prizes) will take place on 21 January 2019 at 2.00pm (AEST) at 417 Barkly Street, Footscray, Victoria. The winner of the Competition will be drawn at this time by automated random selection.

Unclaimed Prize: If a winner is untraceable within five (5) days of the Promoter having made reasonable efforts to locate and contact the winner, or if a winning entry is deemed invalid in accordance with these terms and conditions, the Promoter shall conduct a second chance draw in order to select a new winner. The second chance draw will be open to all eligible entrants who entered the first drawing before the end of the Competition Period and who were not selected as the original winner. The second chance draw shall take place on 29 January 2019 at 12.00 noon (AEST) at 417 Barkly Street, Footscray, Victoria. The winner of the second chance draw will be drawn at this time by automated random selection. The winner of the second chance draw shall be notified by telephone and/or email and the winner's name will be published online at www.westernbulldogs.com.au on 29 February 2019.

Ineligible Persons: The following persons are ineligible to win the prize for themselves or on behalf of any other person:

- (a) office holders, management, employees and contractors of the Promoter;
- (b) any nominee, retailer or supplier associated with the Competition;
- (c) immediate family members of persons listed in (a) and (b) (note that 'immediate family members' means spouse (including a de facto spouse), parent, natural or adoptive child and sibling (whether natural or adoptive), whether or not they live in the same household as the person listed in (a) and (b)).

Privacy: All personal information you provide will be held and used by the Promoter, the AFL and by selected third parties in accordance with the Promoter's Privacy Policy which can be found at www.westernbulldogs.com.au/privacy. Your personal information will be kept securely and confidentially. The promoter may use your personal information for promotional and direct marketing activities and for other purposes as specified in the Privacy Policy. By entering this Competition and providing your personal information, you agree to receive emails from the Promoter. Although you may choose not to provide us with certain information, please be aware that this choice may affect your eligibility to win this Competition. Entrants can advise the Promoter at any time if they no longer wish to receive information from the Promoter or its affiliates by contacting the Promoter's Privacy Officer at privacy.officer@westernbulldogs.com.au. The Promoter may continue to provide entrants with information for an indefinite period unless and until advised otherwise by entrants.

General Terms and Conditions:

1. No responsibility is accepted by the Promoter for any late, lost, misdirected, incomplete, ineligible or illegible entries (including lost, stolen, forged, defaced or damaged entries), nor for any system errors or other issues which may result in disruption to, lost, delayed or unreceived entries or winner notifications or for any other matters beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter. The Promoter and/or its representatives may conduct verification checks in their absolute discretion to determine the whether an entrant is eligible to enter the Competition. Any ineligible entries will be deemed to be invalid and will not be included in the Competition.
2. The drawing of prize will be conducted in accordance with the Competition Draw Details. If a winning entry is deemed invalid, that entry will be disregarded and the prize will be awarded by drawing the next valid entry in accordance with these terms and conditions.



3. If an entry is deemed invalid (at the Promoter's discretion) prior to the Prize Claim Date, the Promoter may determine a new winner in accordance with the Unclaimed Prize arrangements.
4. The Promoter may, in its sole discretion, declare any or all entries made by an entrant invalid, and/or prohibit further participation by an entrant in this Competition, if the entrant:
 - (a) is deemed by the Promoter to breach these terms and conditions;
 - (b) disrupts, abuses, threatens, harasses or attempts to do any of these things to the Promoter, another entrant, potential entrant, or anyone else associated with this Competition; or
 - (c) engages in conduct in relation to this Competition which is misleading, deceptive, fraudulent or damaging to the Promoter's goodwill or reputation.

If the prize, or an element of the prize, is unavailable for any reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute another prize of equal or greater value for that prize, or element of it, subject to the approval of any relevant authority. The Promoter and its representatives will not be liable for any damage to or delay in transit of the prize.
6. Prize value is accurate as at the date of preparing these terms and conditions and include any applicable GST. Any variation in the value of the prize after that date is beyond the Promoter's control. All costs, fees, charges or expenses associated with the prize are the responsibility of the prize winner, unless specifically stated otherwise. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in prize value. - (a) loss that was not reasonably foreseeable;

 - (c) business losses or losses suffered by non-consumers; or
 - (d) losses caused by factors which could reasonably be considered to be outside the control of the Promoter (such as faults in third party equipment);
